

VOLUNTEER INFORMATION GUIDE

Rescue Center & School Project – Mombasa, Kenya

Thank you for your interest in volunteering with us! This guide provides you with all the practical details regarding your stay, accommodation, and financial responsibilities. Please read it carefully before submitting your application.

1. Accommodation & Meals

To make your stay safe and comfortable, we arrange local accommodation for our volunteers.

- **Where you will live:** You will stay in a dedicated volunteer house close to the project. Rooms are clean and secure but simple (e.g., standard Kenyan plumbing, mosquito nets provided).
- **Meals:** Three meals a day are included. You will enjoy traditional Kenyan food (such as ugali, rice, beans, chapati, and fresh fruit).

2. Your Financial Contribution

As a non-profit organization operating in a low-income suburb, 100% of our funds go directly toward the children's education, food, and medical care. Therefore, we cannot cover the costs for volunteers.

The Volunteer Fee is 100 Euro per week.

What is INCLUDED:

- Airport pickup in Mombasa (MBA)
- Accommodation
- Three meals per day
- Orientation and 24/7 on-site support from our team
- A certificate of completion at the end of your stay

What is NOT included (Your responsibility):

- International flights to Kenya
- Tourist Visa (eVisa / ETA for Kenya)
- Travel health insurance (mandatory)
- Required vaccinations and malaria prophylaxis
- Taxi costs from / to Mombasa airport
- Personal spending money for weekend trips or snacks

3. Living and Working Conditions

Our project is located in an underprivileged suburb of Mombasa. This means you will experience the true, warm hospitality of Kenya, but you will also face the realities of poverty.

- **The Environment:** Resources at the school and orphanage are limited. Creativity is key! If you want to do arts and crafts, you will often need to improvise with simple materials.
- **Working Hours:** Typically Monday to Friday, from around 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Weekends are free for you to explore Mombasa, visit the beaches, or go on a safari.
