

IMPROVEMENT OF SECURITY

Infrastructure improvement for official recertification

Project overview

As part of the orphanage's official recertification process, local authorities issued specific regulatory requirements to upgrade the facility. These mandatory directives primarily focused on improving the children's safety regarding fire protection, burglary prevention, and basic hygiene standards.

Before

Prior to these upgrades, the main entrance gate was severely rusted and could barely be closed, leaving the facility vulnerable. Furthermore, the dormitory windows were permanently barred and could not be opened, blocking critical escape routes in the event of a fire, while the dilapidated toilet doors failed to meet basic sanitary and privacy regulations.



After

The main security gate has been completely replaced, which also required the structural reinforcement of the support pillars on both sides. The dormitory windows have been upgraded with new models that can be easily opened from the inside during an emergency to serve as a reliable fire escape. Additionally, all worn-out toilet doors have been replaced with new, hygienic, and functional ones.

Impact

These comprehensive upgrades drastically elevate the overall safety, fire protection, and hygiene standards for everyone at the center, creating a secure environment where the children can thrive. Most importantly, successfully implementing these structural improvements fulfills all official requirements, securing the mandatory recertification of the rescue center by the responsible Ministry of Labour and Social Protection in Nairobi.
